# **Final Project: EldaCare**

# **Project Abstract**

**EldaCare** is an innovative concept that utilizes the smartphone and smartwatch to help people care for their senior relatives, especially those with early stage of Alzheimer's Disease. Those who are caring for their senior relatives, or care partners, can help manage their senior relatives' daily activities from the smartphone. They can set the tasks and time to remind what their senior relatives need to do, and set how many points they will get when the task is completed. Once a task is set, the task is sent to the senior relative's smartwatch. When it's time for the senior relative to do a task, the smartwatch will activate with a notification and senior relative will perform the chore. Then the senior relative sends a notification to their care partner through the smartwatch to indicate the task is completed.
